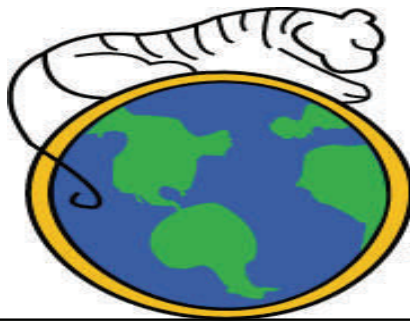

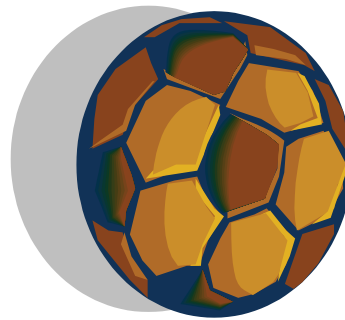

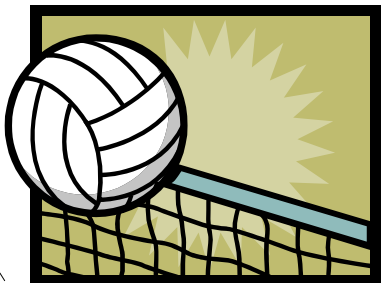


### Flower Sale

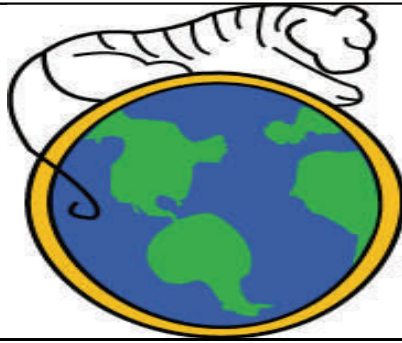
### Morning Car Line
